NUI'S COVID RESPONSE

Alhamdulillah, for an amazing school year during a very uncertain time. The NUI Administration worked throughout the summer to ensure a smooth school opening in September 2020. Throughout the summer teachers and administrators engaged in workshops to redesign curriculum for hybrid and remote learning. NUI started the school year remote but was able to implement strict guidelines from the state and CDC and transition to hybrid. A Task Force of community physicians provided guidance for a safe re-opening. Alhamdulillah NUI did not have any cases of COVID transmission within the school or school events. Increased sanitization and strict adherence to COVID guidelines and school protocols, including a new HVAC system, helped maintain a healthy and safe learning environment.

To facilitate a smooth remote and hybrid experience for students and staff, the school invested in new technology and IT platforms. The introduction of Schoology allowed students and parents to access course work whether they were home or in school. The technology advancements made within a few months allowed the highest level of academic support. NUI administrators and teachers also worked diligently to support the emotional and psychological well-being of students with extra office hours, counseling office hours, and fun activities online and on site to bring students together. Of course, the core of NUI is spiritual learning. The Islamic Studies, Quran and Arabic Departments, with the leadership of their Department chairs, provided daily morning adhkar, NUI Scholar Series, and a curriculum that instilled the values and principles of Islam. The focus was on helping students maintain a strong eeman and reliance on Allah (swt) even in the most trying times.
